



BUTLER TRANSIT AUTHORITY: NEW TERMINAL

The Butler Transit Authority relocated their City of Butler Bus Terminal to a new location. The new location was nearer to the western residential area of the city, was close to many of the local service providers and the City of Butler Safety Building and was on a less busy street. This relocation required renovations of a building on West Newcastle Street. The space accommodates passengers waiting for the fixed route bus pickups and is a transfer point for passengers going from one route to another. The facility included a large waiting area, new accessible restrooms, office and ticket center, and bus driver lounge.
